What Is Boot Camp?

The Church Planting Boot Camp is an intensive five-day training experience that covers the major issues church planters face in their first year in starting a new church.

Boot Camp is designed for

- Planters
- Spouses
- Lay leaders
- Coaches

The best use of Boot Camp is to come as a church planting team with your spouse, lay leaders and coach.



BOOT CAMP OBJECTIVE

The Boot Camp training objective is to give church planters practical skills that will help them build healthy, growing, multiplying churches.

BOOT CAMP VISION

The Boot Camp vision is to equip ordinary leaders with startup skills to break the 100/200/reproduction barriers in order to plant healthy, growing, reproducing churches.

CHURCH PLANTING PRINCIPLES

Boot Camp will tackle 30 start up issues every planter faces.

It is critical that a planter takes the time to establish a solid foundation for his plant (Luke 14: 28-32)

5. Missional Context: Where do you want to plant and how will that impact your ministry design?
